4. New Business

- Sherando Showcase Updates Kayla Wright
 - Registration started this Sunday at noon. Last year had 36 units total. We are already at 54 units. Joel Cosner added we're already the third largest AIA North Show.
 - Kayla said registered groups include one winds, one concert percussion, 12 percussion, 40 guard (including both of JMUs)
 - We can only take a max of 60
 - With this many groups, we're probably starting the day at 8 a.m. and ending it around 8 p.m.
 - All ticket sales and concessions sales come back to the band program
 - o Looking to have an array of vendors again
 - o Guy any national brands that would want to sponsor?
 - Kayla will look into Field & Floor from PA, etc...

- Golf Tournament Committee Guy Curtis

7. Band Director Report - Joel Cosner

Since the last meeting - did all concert/symphonic auditions. Grading assistance
was provided by Chris Kilkus, Scott Kitrell, and some students from Shenandoah
University. Only about three weeks of preparation for the winter concert. He feels

like the students have gotten more attentive with being on stage during the past couple of days. He feels like he's been able to get into details with both of the bands. He thinks this sets up positively for the concert assessment process, which comes next. He's looking at a number of pieces for assessment. He appreciates those who have helped to step up at playoff games when he was unavailable. He appreciates all the support. He's really proud of the work that's being done and the resources for the kids. Will do an assessment clinic day on Feb. 17, with guest conductors. He thinks an active organization is a sign of a strong organization.
